RIGUL - TIBET

"Rigul is the community in what is now designated as being of Sichuan province of China. This is where Ringu Tulku Rinpoche was born and where he spent the first 7 years of his life. Due to the changed geo-political situation since he was a young boy, Ringu Tulku has been living in India and extensively traveling the world delivering teachings. The Rigul Trust Charity has been established to ensure the social wellbeing and health security of the hundreds of people who still live there even though Ringu Tulku Rinpoche no longer resides there. By supporting the Rigul trust Charity it not only helps the local community of Rigul but also helps Rinpoche to deliver teachings around the world in the knowledge that those who still live in his place of birth are being cared for."

Rigul is a village in the rugged Kham region of eastern Tibet. Most of the population continue to raise yaks for food, income and heating fuel. The nearest town and hospital are far away. Rigul Trust funded underground water piping system to the village from the river
